

Great news! You're eligible for Medicaid health coverage starting in January 2019. This means you will receive all the benefits you have now, plus more!

Hi GAP member,

I have great news for you! Due to a rules change in Virginia, and you are a current GAP member, effective on January 1, 2019, **you will be eligible for Medicaid health coverage.** To make it as easy as possible for you to receive your new benefits, we will handle the enrollment for you. **You do not need to apply. Virginia Medicaid will provide all the benefits you have now, plus many more including:**

- ✓ Doctor visits
- ✓ Hospital and emergency room services
- ✓ Prescriptions
- ✓ Lab work and X-rays
- ✓ Maternity and newborn care
- ✓ Mental health care, including addiction and recovery treatment
- ✓ Family planning services
- ✓ Medical equipment and supplies
- ✓ Preventative and wellness services
- ✓ And much more!

However, if you receive a letter from CoverVA about your annual re-enrollment for GAP, you must respond to CoverVA and keep your GAP coverage to ensure you will be enrolled in the new Medicaid program.

Here's what will happen next:

1. Look out for more mail from us!
 - You will receive more information from us in November.
 - You will receive an official notice that you have been approved for Medicaid and a blue and white Medicaid ID card in the mail.
 - You will also receive information about the Medicaid health plan to which you have been assigned and how you can change to a different plan if you would like. You may also want to talk to your doctor or health care providers about which Medicaid health plans they participate in.
2. Your new MCO will assign a care coordinator.
 - This is a person to help you get the care you need.
 - You will be provided information about how to reach that care coordinator in the letter you will receive telling you to which MCO you are assigned.
3. Start using your new benefits on January 1, 2019! Until that time, please continue to use your GAP identification card to receive medical and behavioral health services.
